Policy Statement:

College Classes for Students:

Students have the opportunity to take college classes offered at various colleges and universities.

Curriculum and Availability:

It is the responsibility of the SBDM Council to make appropriate arrangements for AP and Dual Credit courses to be offered.

Student Assignment (Placement) and Recruitment:

We encourage all students to prepare for and take one or more college-level courses. We will do that in the following ways:

1. Counselors will advise students and parents of these opportunities during scheduling conferences and parent meetings throughout the school year, as well as encourage students to take the appropriate preparatory courses.
2. In September, the principal will report to the council on enrollment in these course by total numbers, gender, ethnicity, participate in the free and reduced lunch program, and disability status.
3. Based on data, SBDM may amend the CSIP to add additional steps to ensure equitable participation in future terms.

Exceptions:

Advanced Placement and Dual Credit courses will be an exception in that there will be a minimum class size set at the discretion of the principal.
