POLICY STATEMENT


TEACHER RESPONSIBILITY In the fall semester, all teachers will be trained in development of writing prompts and rubrics as well as scoring of student work for KCCT Open Response, On Demand and Portfolio pieces. Training in appropriate classroom writing practices and ethical grading will also be provided for all teachers. All new Bourbon County High School faculty and members of the portfolio scoring team will be trained to score the Grade 12 KCCT Portfolio. Veteran faculty have the option to attend training for scoring the Grade 12 KCCT Portfolio. By March 1, all teachers, except Math teachers, will submit one writing per course that is suitable for inclusion in the Grade 12 Portfolio.

NON-ACCOUNTABILITY YEAR PORTFOLIOS GRADES 9-10-11 English teachers will monitor progress of portfolio development in grades 9-10- and 11.

ACCOUNTABILITY YEAR GRADE 12 Grade 12 English teachers will supervise all students in English IV (regardless of graduation status) in the selection of required pieces and completion of portfolio. An apprentice level portfolio is required for graduation from Bourbon County High School (effective in 2002).
Exception: IEP/504/ELL
